PART III: WITHDRAWAL/CANCELLATION POLICIES

Introduction: The decision to enroll in the NUin Australia program involves a significant investment of money and requires a commitment on the part of the participant to fully prepare and engage in the process in order to experience the program's full benefits. Individuals are urged to plan carefully and be completely familiar with the withdrawal policies before applying.

The NUin Australia refund policies supersede the Northeastern University on-campus refund policies. A student withdrawing from the program at any time after enrolling is responsible for all non-recoverable expenses paid by Northeastern University.

Prior to start of the NUin Australia Program: If a student withdraws from the program within 30 days of departure there will be an administrative fee charged to the participant's account in addition to any other non-recoverable costs such as: airfare, housing, program costs, transportation, staffing.

After start of programs:

If a participant withdraws from a travel abroad program, the participant is not eligible for any refund of non-recoverable costs including, but not limited to the following situations:

- ◆ Illness or accident
- ◆ Homesickness
- ◆ Family emergency
- ◆ Language difficulties
- ◆ Adjustment issues due to climate, geography, etc.
- ◆ Political unrest

Medical Leave of Absence: Due to the non-recoverable costs associated with studying and traveling abroad, the University's medical and non-medical leaves of absence policies do not apply to individuals participating in International Travel Programs.

Program Cancellation/Suspension Policies

If the U.S. State Department issues an official recommendation to evacuate U.S. nationals from a country in which Northeastern University offers a program, Northeastern University will suspend or cancel the program in that country and:

- All students are required to return immediately to the U.S.
- Only recoverable program fees will be refunded to those students already participating, or preparing to participate, in that particular program
- Program participants and accepted applicants are not entitled to any refund if and when there is a threat or an outbreak of war
- If the program is suspended or cancelled prior to the program start date, we will work with students to transfer to another NU program if they wish

PART IV: PROGRAM POLICIES

- Northeastern University reserves the right to deny participants the opportunity to participate in NUin Australia if they are placed on probation, deferred suspension, or do not follow University rules and expectations regarding conduct. - The University reserves the right to withdraw a participant's acceptance if academic standards are not maintained, disciplinary action is taken against the participant and/or other information becomes available that would threaten the well-being of the applicant or other participants on the program.

- I understand that this is a Northeastern University sponsored program and therefore, subject to all academic, judicial, and financial responsibilities.
