March 1	September/Fall admission: Deadline for Nursing and Physical Therapy applicants
May 1	September/Fall admission: Deadline for all other majors
October 15	January/Spring admission: Deadline for International applicants
November 1	January/Spring admission: Deadline for Domestic applicants, all majors*

No transfer applicants for Pharmacy, Health Science, and Undeclared/Undecided.

*No January applicants for Nursing, Physical Therapy, Architecture, Music Technology, and Studio Art.

- 🐾 Official final high school transcript or GED score report and SAT/ACT scores. *These requirements are waived if you have completed more than 24 semester hours of college-level academic work, or if you have been out of high school for more than five years.*
- 🐾 Midterm grades for the current term

- 🐾 Official copy of your course registration list with in-progress course titles, numbers and credit values.
