FRESHMAN APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & ELECTRONIC/POSTMARK DEADLINES

November 1	September/Fall admission: application deadline for Early Action
January 15	September/Fall admission: application deadline for Regular Decision
October 15	January/Spring admission: application deadline for International students
November 1	January/Spring admission: application deadline for U.S citizens or permanent residents

No January entrance for Nursing, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, Health Science, Music Technology, Studio Art, or Architecture

- ❃ Official SAT (College Code is 3667) or ACT results (College Code is 1880)
- ❃ Transcripts from any college-level course work
- ❃ Portfolio materials**
- ❃ Resume (recommended)
