<b>May 1</b>	September/Fall admission: application deadline for all majors
<b>October 15</b>	January/Spring admission: application deadline for International applicants
<b>November 1</b>	January/Spring admission: application deadline for U.S. citizens or permanent residents*

### **Important Information:**

No transfer entrance for Nursing, Physical Therapy, Pharmacy, Health Science, and Undeclared/Undecided.

\*No January entrance for Architecture, Music Technology, and Studio Art.

- ✿ Official college course transcript(s)
- ✿ One letter of recommendation on letterhead (preferably from a professor)
- ✿ College Official's Report (available at [www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org))
- ✿ Official final high school transcript or GED score report and SAT/ACT scores. *These requirements are waived if you have completed more than 24 semester hours of college-level academic work, or if you have been out of high school for more than five years.*
- ✿ Midterm grades for the current term

- ✿ Official copy of your course registration list with in-progress course titles, numbers and credit values.
