



## Latino/a Student Cultural Center

The Latino/a Student Cultural Center (LSCC) provides resources to support the social, cultural, and academic experiences of Latino/a students at Northeastern. The center also promotes interaction between the University and the surrounding Latino and Caribbean communities.

The LSCC helps ensure student success through a broad array of services, ranging from academic advising and career counseling to cultural events and social activities. The center also helps students identify strategies for college success.

The LSCC is a hub of activity for Northeastern's students. The center's building houses many offices, including a space used by student organizations and the office of the Latino/a, Latin-American, and Caribbean Studies (LLACS) Program. Students use the LSCC as a home-away-from-home; a place to relax between classes and socialize. The seminar/conference room is available for classes, meetings, lunches, dinners, and even domino tournaments. This space also contains a computer lab and media equipment for cultural activities.

### Scholarships

La Comunidad Latina en Acción (LaCLA) Scholarship Committee administers annual full-tuition awards for returning students (room and board is not included). The scholarship encourages students to perform community service in Boston-area Latino/a neighborhoods.
