The current edition of the directory lists approximately 4,500 Black, Hispanic, American Indian, Asian American, and women students in nearly 80 fields in the sciences, engineering, the social sciences and the humanities.” The entire directory is very expensive, but you can reduce costs by purchasing rosters for specific disciplines.
