1. A completed application form (Page 2 of this document).
2. A copy of your resume.
3. A copy of your most recent transcript.
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation (from people who are familiar with your abilities, interests and motivation towards research).
5. A one-page write-up indicating which ALERT Project(s) you would be interested in working on and a description of how this project fits your background and interests. You may indicate your interest in more than one project and you may also describe other types of research that you would be interested in working on.
