The deadline to apply for the Professional/Management Internships only is February 17th. The deadline to apply for most other

Professional Internship positions is March 2nd.

The professional internships are [full time/paid positions ranging from \\$9.25-14/hour. For the engineering and technical positions, the salaries range from \\$13-18/hour.<<](#)
