

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR BOUVE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF HEALTH SCIENCES.

Prospective graduate students apply to the Bouvé Graduate School of Health Sciences. It is preferred that all official transcripts and current nursing licenses be submitted in one envelope directly to:

Once your application file is complete, the Graduate School will communicate with you via email and your file will be forwarded to the department committee. The final admissions decisions are made by the Bouvé Graduate School of Health Sciences upon recommendation of the department committee.

Special Student status

Students who are interested in earning up to 12 semester hours of graduate credit prior to applying to a degree program may apply as Special Students up to two weeks prior to class beginning. Special Students must apply directly to the Bouvé Graduate School of Health Sciences by completing the online application (<https://app.applyyourself.com/?id=neu-grad>) with application fee, official transcripts confirming an earned bachelor's degree and, in the case of nursing, an up to date nursing license. The supporting documents should be sent in one envelope to Hattie Williams at the above address.

Students should indicate the course that interests them in case faculty approval is necessary for course attendance or the class has reached capacity.

Upon approval of special student status, the office of Graduate Admissions instruct you on registration procedures.
