

# Experiential Learning Grant (ELG)

College of Arts and Sciences

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The College of Arts and Sciences' Center for Academic Services has established a grant program to encourage students to pursue experiential education opportunities. The Experiential Learning Grant will make a limited number of awards available to Arts and Sciences students to support a range of activities, including co-op, community service, internships, artistic performance, and others that extend and enhance traditional classroom instruction.

Individual projects by students may be done during a regular term or on co-op. The award is intended to support students who are participating in an experiential learning project and to defray costs such as materials, travel, equipment, and so on. It cannot be used as a stipend.

Proposals should be developed by the student with advice from a faculty member, and must be co-signed by the sponsoring faculty mentor. Students who receive awards are required to write a short summary of their project that must be signed by the faculty mentor. Students may be asked to make a brief presentation at a CAS event.

**Awards** Individual awards up to \$1000. Group awards will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

A complete application includes all of the following items.

(Incomplete applications will **not** be accepted.)

- 1. ELG Application Form**
- 2. A One-Page Description of the Proposed Project (written by the student)**  
Please describe your proposed project and the project's benefit to your educational or career goals.
- 3. Budget (detailed description of expenses)**
- 4. Letter of Support from the Faculty Mentor**
- 5. NU Transcript (copy is acceptable)**

**February 25, 2010 for Spring or Spring/Summer Projects**
