

The Double Husky Scholarship



What is it?

The Double Husky Scholarship provides an up-to-25% tuition discount to all alumni with a bachelor's degree from Northeastern when they enroll in one of more than 100 full-time master's degree or certificate programs (restrictions apply).

Who is eligible?

All graduates with a Northeastern bachelor's degree are eligible for the Double Husky Scholarship.

See reverse for included programs. Doctorate programs are not eligible.

Students must apply and be admitted to an approved full-time master's degree or graduate certificate program and must maintain full-time enrollment each term (though full-time status may vary by program).

Students must enroll during the 2012-2013 or 2013-2014 academic year.

How do I apply?

Application decisions are made by each graduate college and applicants submit their materials directly to the graduate program of their choice. If admitted and enrolled, a student is responsible for covering all fees beyond his or her Double Husky award.

Northeastern receives applications through an on-line system. Program applications and admissions details can be found at www.northeastern.edu/graduate.

Note that the application fee is waived for prospective Double Husky students.

Northeastern alumni are automatically considered for the scholarship. Upon acceptance, an eligible student will receive a letter from his or her college indicating the percentage of tuition discount that applies to Double Husky Scholarship recipients in that college.
