

Request for Proposals for Mobile Learning Digital Media Curriculum Project

The Office of the Provost and the EdTech Center seek proposals from faculty interested in developing a Mobile Digital Media Project or Mobile Application that requires using an iPad2, camera, or audio recorder for a course.



In order to be considered, faculty must:

1. Submit a brief RFP outlining mobile digital media project or mobile application with iPad2, camera, or audio recorder for a course (see proposal requirements below)
2. Meet with EdTech Center for a one-on-one consultation to begin proposal work. Faculty are awarded product to use for RFP implementation and, once project is completed, the faculty may keep the product for future use
3. Document process via EdTech blog and present process and project results at an EdTech Talk
4. Allow EdTech Center to document project and produce a digital story to publish via web

Support for a mobile learning project will include:

- One-on-one faculty consultation with the EdTech Center on designing, integrating, and evaluating mobile projects
- Training for faculty on using iPad2, camera, or audio recorder
- On-going faculty support from EdTech Center throughout the project

Please submit a proposal and provide the following information:

1. Name of lead faculty member
2. Department/program
3. Course name
4. Approximate # of students who will be participating/benefiting
5. Goal of the mobile digital media project or mobile application
6. Description of how you envision the project or application to work
7. Description of your previous experience working with mobile devices and/or media in the classroom, if any.
8. Commitment to adequate time to planning and completing the design and development for a mobile digital media project during current semester
9. Please include a statement of support from the department chair

Proposals will be evaluated by the EdTech Center on the following criteria:

- Significance of the mobile digital media project or mobile application and the impact on student learning by incorporating technology.
- Plans for sharing the course project experience with others (i.e. making a presentation at an EdTech Talks).
- Project's overall feasibility, likelihood of success, and alignment with the stated goals of the course.
