This fall, new members will be initiated into Northeastern University's Order of Omega Chapter. Information about the National Order of Omega and requirements for consideration of membership are below. The application is attached to this letter.

PURPOSE OF OMEGA

- To recognize those fraternity men and women who have attained a high standard of leadership in inter-fraternity activities, to encourage them to continue along this line, and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment;
- To bring together outstanding fraternity men and women to create an organization that will help to mold the sentiment of the institution on questions of local and inter-collegiate fraternity affairs;
- To bring together members of the faculty, alumni, and student members of the institution's fraternities and sororities on a basis of mutual interest, understanding and helpfulness;
- To help create an atmosphere where ideas and issues can be discussed openly across Fraternity and Sorority lines and to help work out solutions.

ELIGIBILITY

The membership of this Order shall be confined to members of Fraternity or Sorority-letter social organizations. The qualifications for membership in Order of Omega shall be character, scholarship, service and leadership. To be eligible for membership in Order of Omega, a student shall meet the following minimum requirements:

- One full academic year of residence at the institution where selected.
- Junior or Senior (undergraduate) standing.
- Have a QPA of 3.0 or above
- Be in good standing with the initiate's fraternal organization.

Each student pays a one-time \$40.00 initiation fee to the Executive Office of the Order of Omega for their certificate and pin.

Applications will be due on Monday, November 2, 2009 and will be reviewed by the Order of Omega executive board and other standing members anonymously.
