FACTS & STATISTICS

Now that you have received a lottery number, it is time to start thinking about your housing selection for Fall 2012. This guide will assist you in answering some of the questions you may have.

What are the chances the room I want will be available when I make my housing selection?

What happens if I am part of the placement process?

Approximately half of all current first year students will be assigned based on their preferences and based on what is available after room selection ends in April. **This is a routine part of our process.**

In mid-March, you will be asked to complete a preference form, list roommate and building choices. Pending sophomores will be assigned daily, as we receive cancellations. This process will be completed by mid-July. Student who are assigned during this process are typically placed in spaces where seniors and juniors cancelled.

Every effort will be made to try to keep your group together, but note that no group is guaranteed to fully stay together whether they select at room selection or are assigned later.
