The facts about housing selection and placement

- Over 6,000 lottery numbers were assigned for the Fall 2009 process
- All members of the classes of 2012 and 2013 are guaranteed housing
- Anyone with a lottery number is eligible to receive housing
- Housing selection is on-line!

How do I know
when to select my
housing?

The selection process for rising sophomores

- If you have a lottery number that is 3500 – 4000 then you will select your housing
- You can pull in any eligible student as your roommate
- You can have a housing staff member select your housing for you if you are not able to do so at your scheduled time

What are my
upper-class
themed housing
options?

Parcel 18

- Opening Fall 2009
- Home to all our new upper-class themed housing options
- State-of-the-art facilities including a cardio work-out room, cyber café, dining hall, terrace, wireless access in the lounges, classroom and meeting spaces
- Semi-private accommodations
 - Single and double rooms with adjoining private bathrooms
- A meal-plan is required for all residents living in this building

The selection schedule for rising sophomores

- THEMED HOUSING SELECTION – March 16th
 - Gender Neutral (from 9am – 2pm)
 - Living Learning Communities (from 3pm - 9pm)
- FILL-AN-APARTMENT SELECTION – March 18
 - 4 & 5 person apartments (from 3 – 9pm)
- GENERAL ROOM SELECTION – March 19
 - (from 9am – 9pm)

The placement process for rising sophomores

- If you have lottery numbers 4001 – 6500 AND you are not pulled into a room you will be part of the placement process
- Students in this process are still guaranteed housing!
- Students are assigned started in late May until mid-July
- In early April you will receive an e-mail update, along with a preference form

How to stay in the know!

- Check your e-mail
- Refer to your lottery number notification e-mail
- Log onto Housing On-line beginning March 7th
- Visit the Housing & Residential Life website
- Attending building tours on March 9, 11 or 12 from 5 – 8:30pm (meet in Speare Commons!)
- Participate in our on-line chat on March 10th from 7 – 8:15pm
