Paying the SEVIS I-901 fee

SEVIS is an acronym for Student and Exchange Visitor Information System. It is a data collection and monitoring system that keeps track of students and exchange visitors and ensures that they maintain their status while in the U.S.

All new F-1 students are subject to a SEVIS I-901 fee. Students may pay the SEVIS fee through the Internet by using credit card and completing the on-line **Form I-901** or through mail by submitting a completed Form I-901 and a check or money order. For detailed information, please refer to the website www.fmjfee.com.

Please note, if you pay the SEVIS fee by credit card, you will be able to print the receipt immediately. If you pay by check or money order, then you must wait for the receipt to be mailed to you. The SEVIS fee cannot be processed at a U.S. Consulate or at a U.S port of entry. F-2 dependents do not have to pay the SEVIS fee.

Students should also be prepared to present the SEVIS fee payment receipt at a U.S. port of entry.
