BONUS QUESTIONS:

1. Laurie is planning on taking her vacation on the Isla de Bioko, and will also make some time to travel to two of her favorite towns, Mbini and Mongomo, which are also located in this country. This will allow her to compare island and continental life. What is the name of the country to which she is travelling? Can you find her the cheapest flight available departing from Boston on July 4, 2009 (destination Malabo) and returning two weeks later? What major event will be co-hosted by this country in 2012?
2. Scott is in need of some peace and quiet, so he plans to travel to an island that has fewer than 50 inhabitants. He has chosen an island that is located in the southernmost extension of the geological archipelago of the Tuamotus, and one of only two places in the world in which the plant species "Glochidion Pitcaimense" lives. He is somewhat concerned about climbing the steep limestone cliffs of sharp coral to get to the hut in which he will be staying, but he has decided that the view from Adamstown is worth seeing. Where is he going? Bonus: There is only one telephone (actually 17 telephones on one party line) in this island community. What is the country code for this telephone?

It is important that we clarify at the onset the responsibilities and expectations of an ISSI Orientation Leader. Although there is no salary offered for the position, the human rewards are beyond measure. In order to deliver the best possible orientation, the International Student & Scholar Institute (ISSI) needs to fully prepare Leaders. Thus, becoming an ISSI Orientation Leader is a commitment to participate in the training session to be held in late August, and to be active in the ISSI Orientation program. **Leaders are expected to adhere fully to their scheduled commitments after they have been agreed upon.** Any changes should be requested in advance from ISSI staff. It is the policy of the ISSI to remain neutral in all religious and political issues in order to be more effective and receptive to the wide variety of people who participate in the program. It is likewise necessary for Leaders to adhere to these policies and to remain as impartial as possible in imposing or promoting their own personal view while representing the ISSI.

The ISSI Orientation program will begin during the last week of August with early immigration clearance and will extend through early November. Intensive involvement occurs primarily during the first week of the program; however, participation on the part of the Leaders is expected throughout the entire program. Once classes begin, most activities are held during evenings and weekends.
