Division Assignment

The university's calendar is comprised of two 15-week semesters (Fall & Spring) and two 7.5-week summer terms. A student's division, chosen during the co-op class, defines the school and co-op periods. Journalism majors are generally split 50/50 between **Division A** and **Division B**.

Tuition

You only pay tuition while you are in classes (8 semesters). You do not pay tuition during co-op periods. However, you're still considered a full-time student and may continue to pay room and board to live in your residence hall while you're on co-op. You may also participate in student organizations, and you continue to have access to all campus resources.
