I am thrilled you are choosing to apply to be a Leadership Consultant. The Leadership Consultant Program is a program that is a part of LEAD 360. As a part of this program student leaders give presentations once a month to their peers about various leadership topics. These topics may include time and priority management, retaining members, leadership styles, etc. In addition, Leadership Consultants is a growing program and requires flexibility in order to benefit from opportunities across campus. Being a part of this new initiative is an exciting opportunity for student leaders on campus. As a Consultant, you must have a willingness to play a part in creating a new leadership program for the campus in order to best meet the needs of Northeastern University students.

Qualified applicants must be a third year, fourth year, or fifth year, have a 2.75 GPA or higher, be involved in the campus and/or community, and have full-time NU student status.

As a Leadership Consultant you are **required** to:

- Attend one training session from 3:00pm – 7:00pm on Sunday, January 10
- Work with a co-presenter to develop your presentation
- Attend two pre-presentation meetings with a staff member
- Give one presentation to current NU students during the semester
- Attend meetings held on the 1st and 15th day of every month to review relevant opportunities

Attached is an application. In addition to the application, there is a 5 minute presentation/facilitation and a 20 minute interview. The presentation/facilitation will be on the topic of your choice relevant to leadership. You will be evaluated on your presentation of ideas and your level of ability to engage the audience.

- Notification of Interview- Friday, December 4
- Interviews and presentations – December 7-9 (various times)
- Attend one training session from 3:00pm – 7:00pm on Sunday, January 10
- Attend a meeting held on the 1st and 15th day of every month to review relevant opportunities
