## Introduction

The Graduating Senior Employment survey is a brief instrument designed to obtain information from graduating seniors regarding their post-graduation plans. Graduating full-time undergraduate students are asked various questions related to employment and graduate school. Currently in its ninth year, this survey provides insight regarding the initial plans of recent graduates. Trend data from the survey is useful in examining patterns of employment and graduate school plans of new graduates.

For the first time this year, administration of this survey was conducted exclusively via an on-line instrument. In March 2006, the survey was placed on the MyNEU web portal of all full-time undergraduate seniors expected to graduate that spring. In all other years, paper surveys were used and administration of the survey was done at time of commencement ticket pickup. Of approximately 1,900 full-time graduating seniors, 693 completed an on-line survey yielding an estimated response rate of 36%. This rate is down significantly compared to the 74% and 49% response rates for the Classes of 2004 and 2005, respectively.

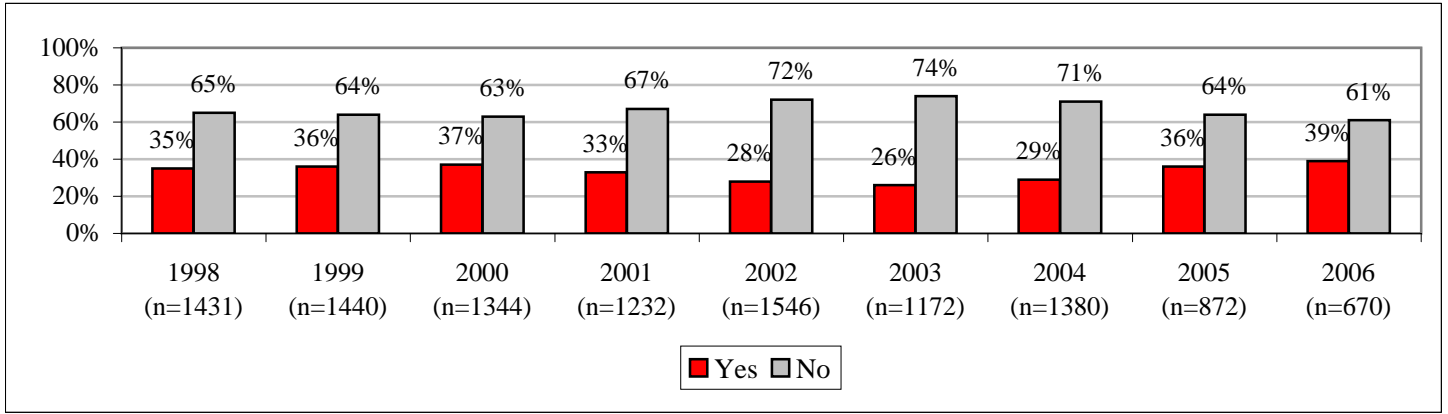

## Summary of Findings

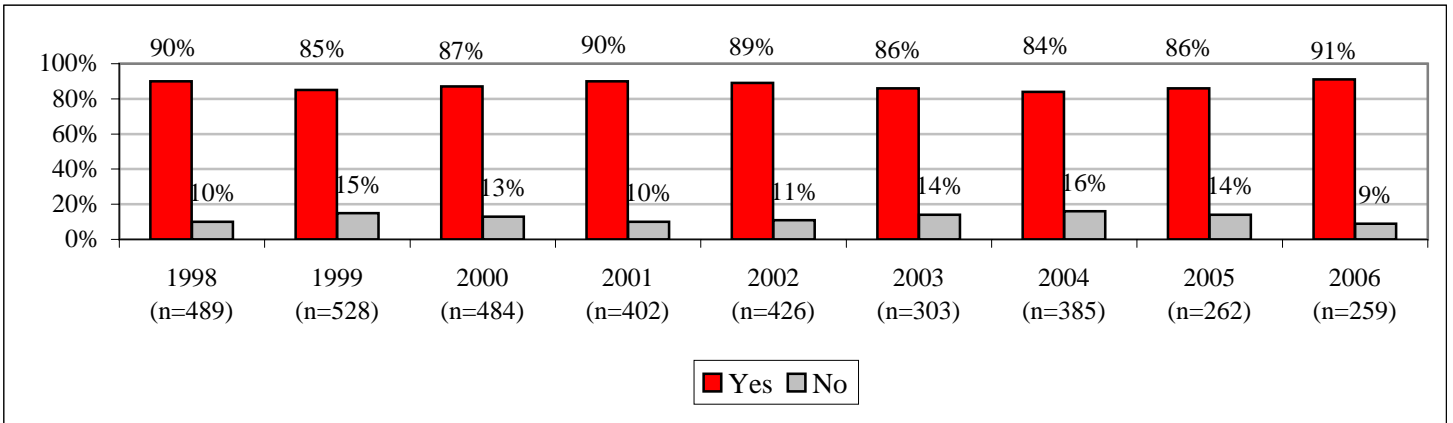
- Thirty-nine percent (39%) of graduates report having secured full-time employment at or before graduation. This figure represents a slight increase from last year's data (36%).
- Compared to last year, slightly more students who have secured full-time employment indicate that this job is related to their field of study (91% vs. 86%).
- Forty-nine percent (49%) of all students who participated in Co-op and have secured a full-time job indicate that this job is with a former Co-op employer. This figure is slightly lower than last year's figure of 54%.
- The mean starting salary for those employed full-time is \$49,611 and the median is \$50,000.
- Among those that participated in Co-op, 47% report having received a full-time job offer from a former Co-op employer.

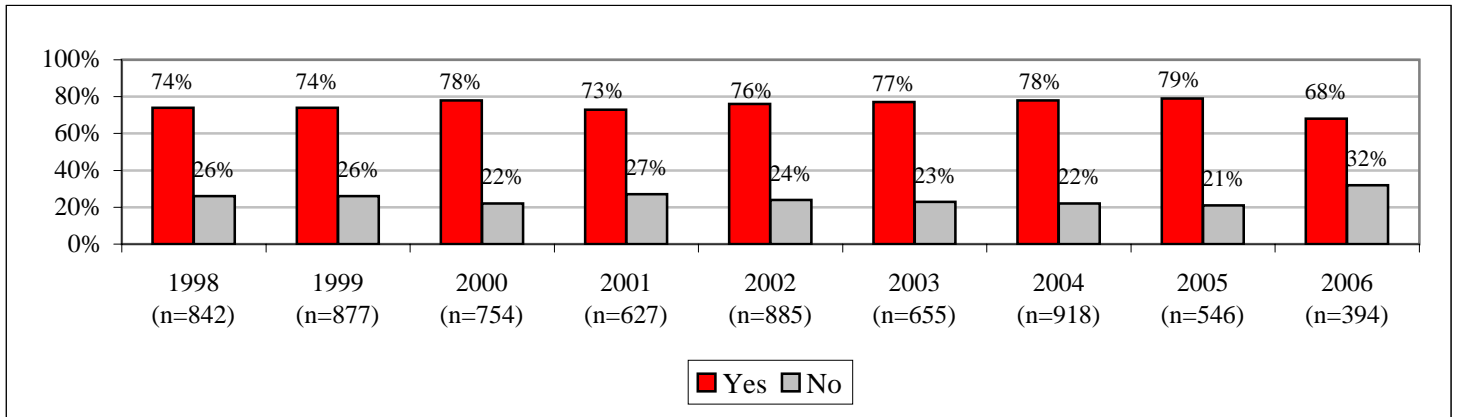
**1. Have you, as yet, secured a full-time job after graduation?**



**2. If yes, is this job related to your field of study?**

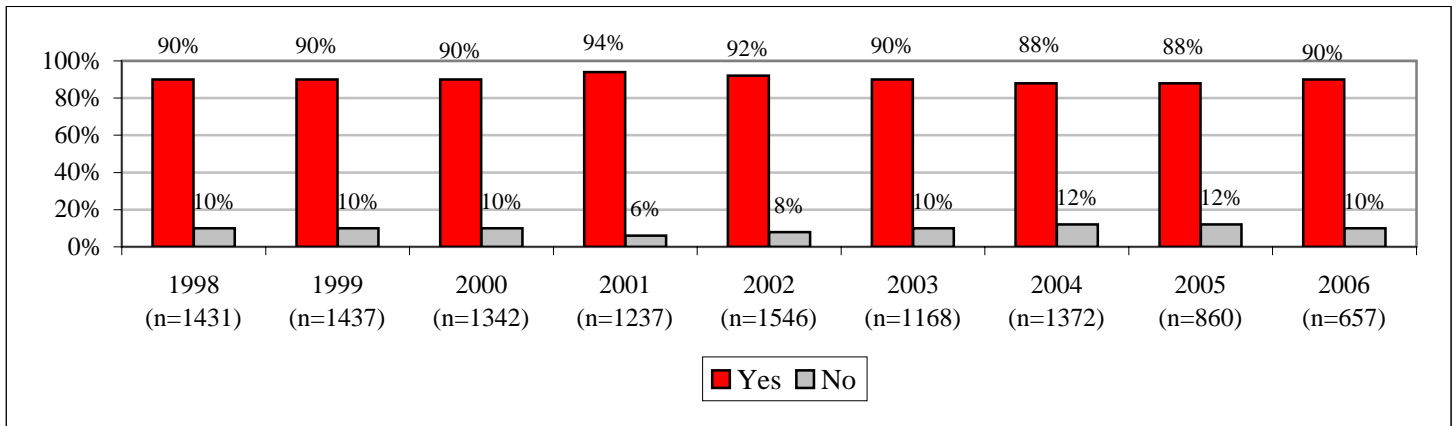


**3. Not having secured a full-time job, are you currently looking for a full-time job?**

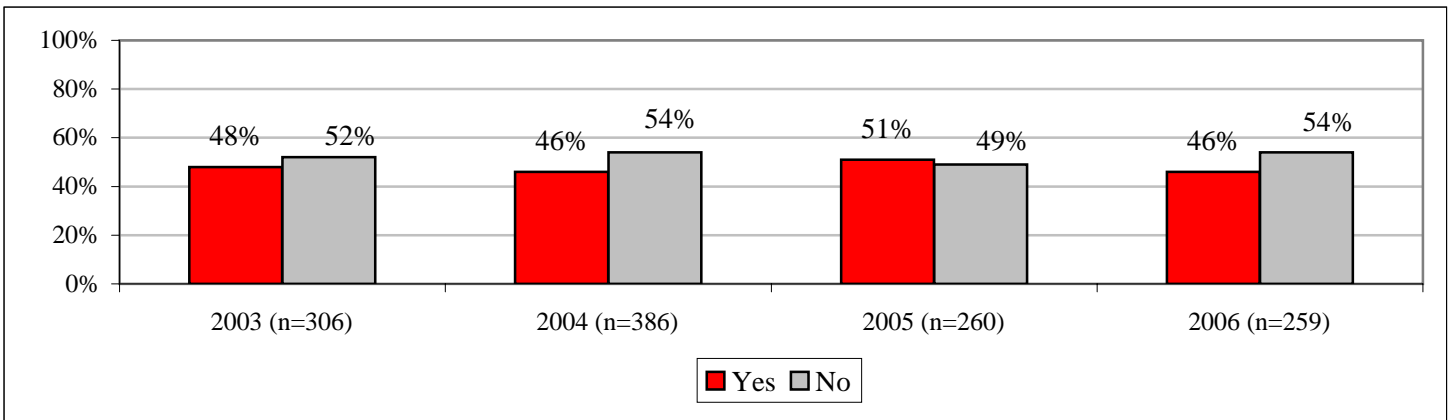

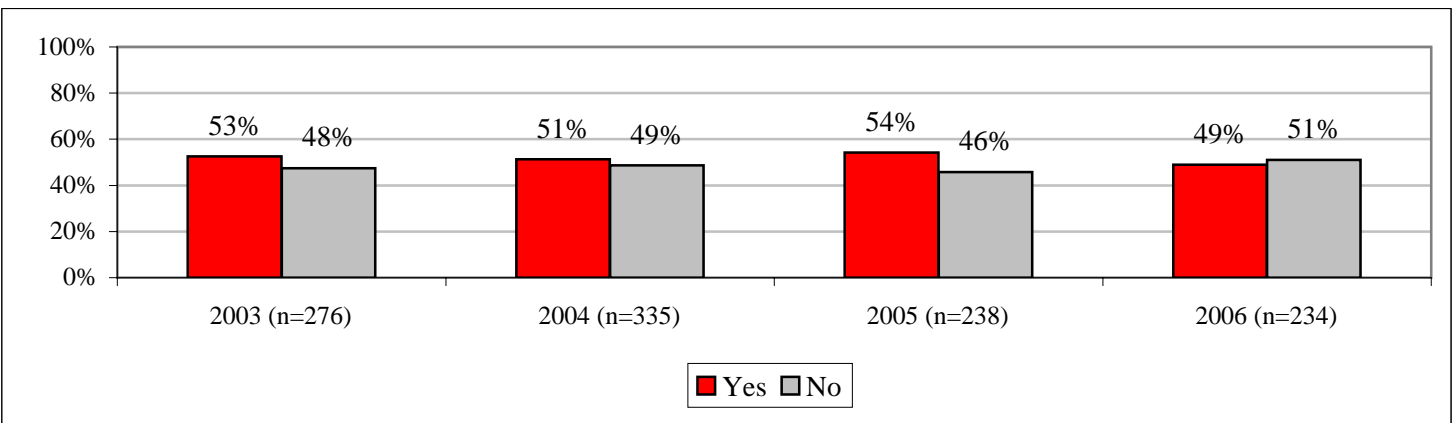
**4. Did you participate in the Co-op Program while at NU?**



**5. Having secured a full-time job, is this job with a former Co-op employer (all students)?**

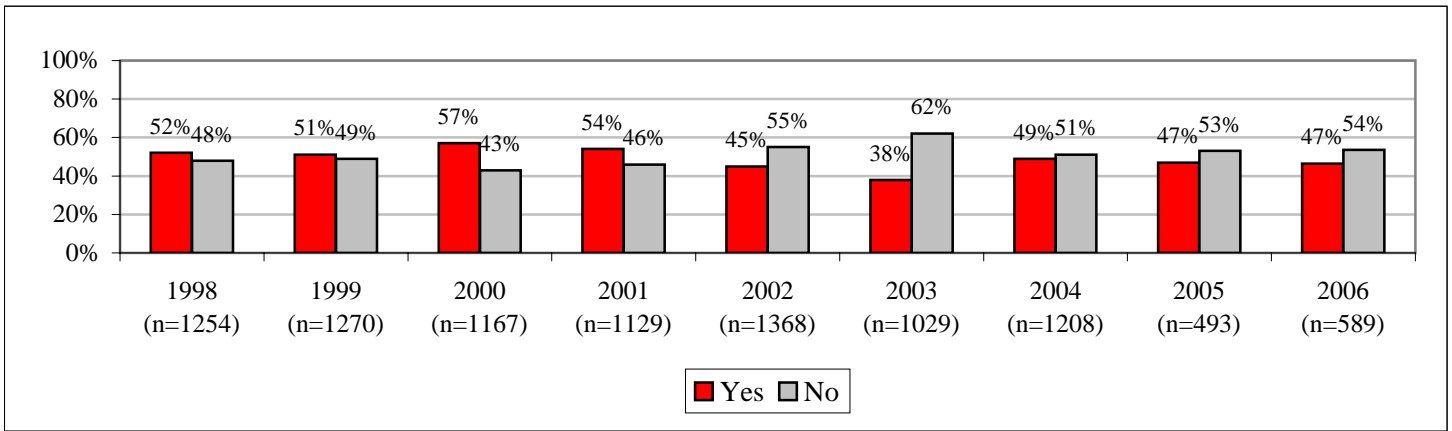


**6. Having secured a full-time job, is this job with a former Co-op employer (students who participated in Co-op)?**

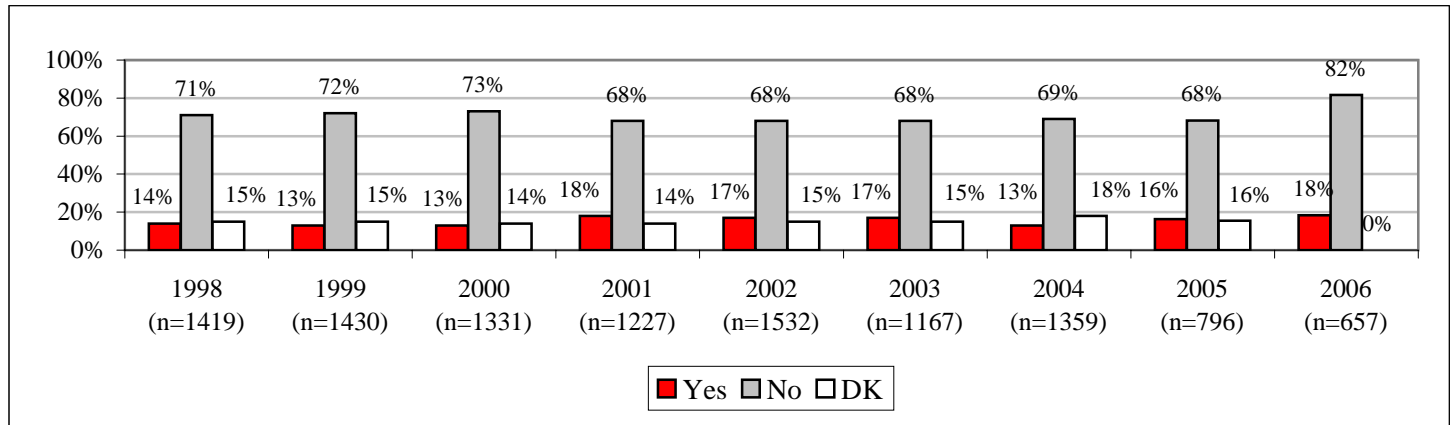

**7. Having participated in Co-op, did any of your Co-op employers offer you a full-time job?**

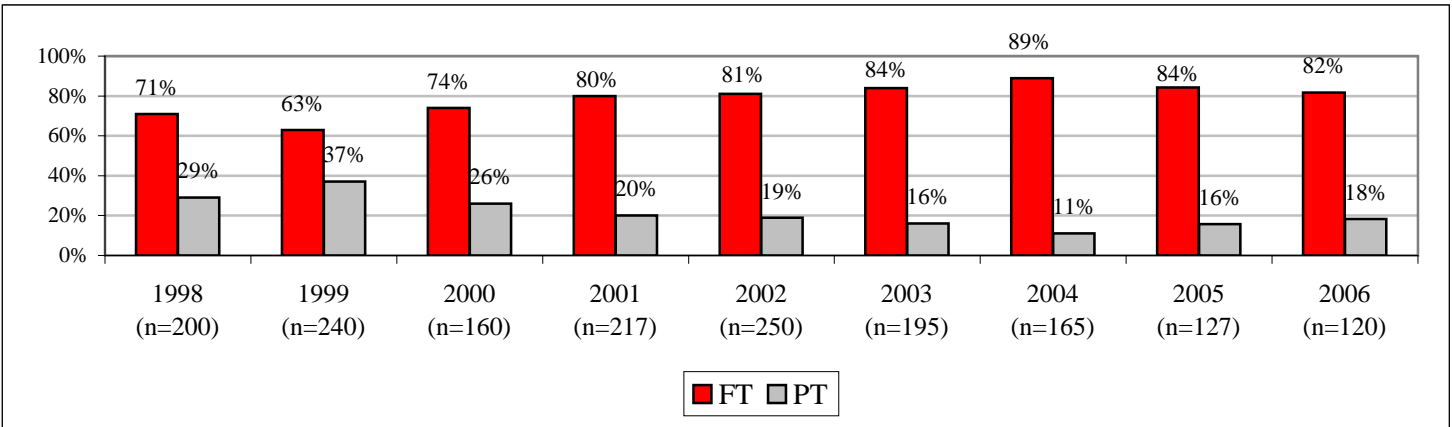


**8. Do you plan to attend graduate school this fall?**

**9. If you are planning to attend graduate school, will that be full-time or part-time?**

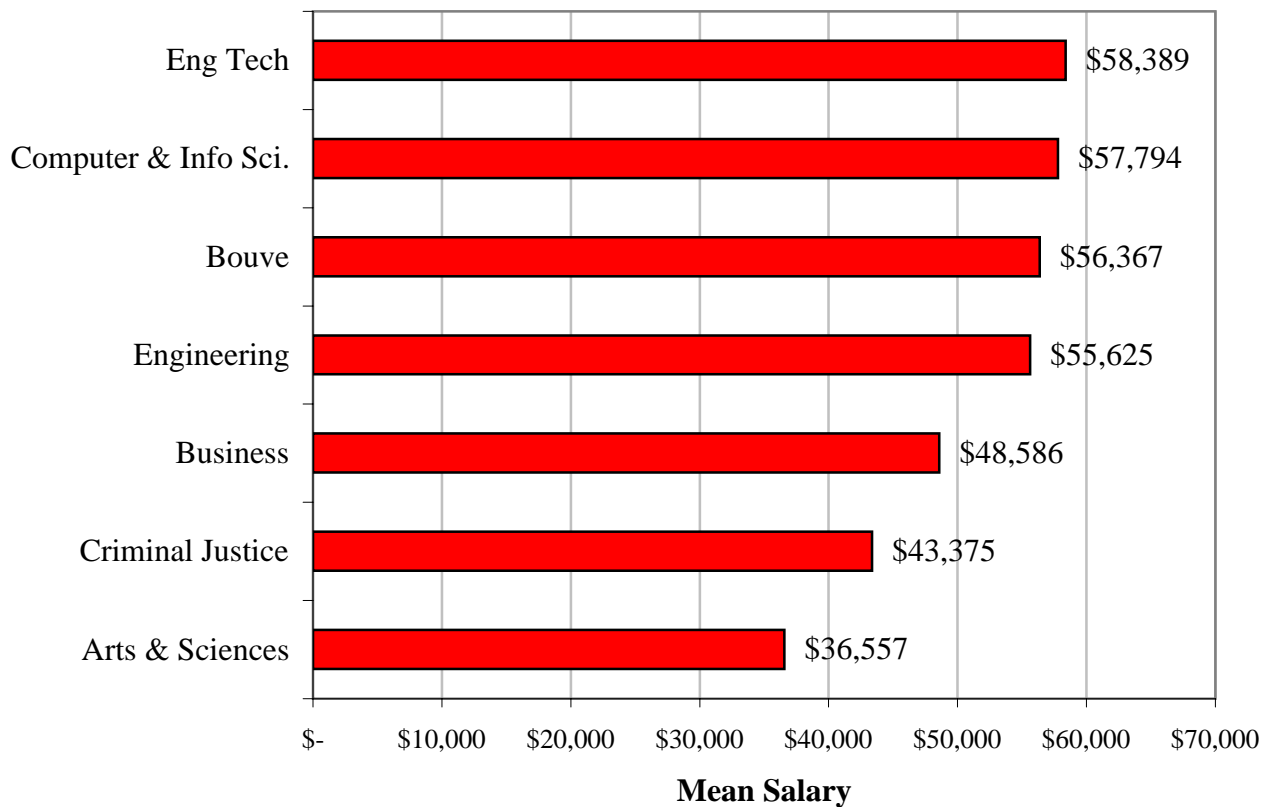
