In order to attend the New Student Orientation on **Friday, January 8, 2010**, you must be an enrolled student, paying the \$200 admission deposit, as well as also having registered for this session through your admitted student portal. Those residing on campus will receive their housing assignment along with move-in information from Housing & Residential Life in December. Listed below is preliminary information which you may find helpful in your planning:

Move-in Date: Thursday, January 7, 2010

Time: 1:00-9:00pm

Parking: You may initially park in the North Parking Lot to unload your belongings. Once you have checked into your residence hall and moved in your belongings, we ask that you please move your vehicle to the **795 Columbus Avenue Parking Garage** and place the enclosed parking pass on your dashboard.

Arrival by Plane/ Logan International Airport

Taxi: 360 Huntington Avenue, Boston. Those students who have a significant amount of luggage may find this method of transportation most beneficial.

Subway: Blue Line **Inbound** to Government Center stop. Change trains to Green Line E train Outbound to Northeastern University stop.

On Friday, January 8, orientation registration will take place in the Curry Student Center, Indoor Quad from 7:00 – 7:30am; a continental breakfast will be available. During orientation you will hear from faculty and staff from your college, meet with your academic advisor, learn more about co-op, and, most importantly, register for classes. In addition, there are many fun 'Welcome Week' activities planned where you will begin to make new friends and meet your classmates!
