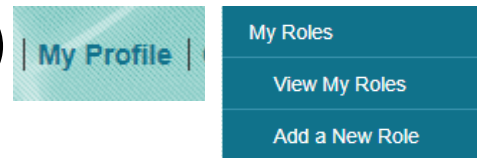

NSF Research.gov: New Functionality


- Use of proposal submission function (for non-collaborative proposals) begins **April 30**
- Testing has been ongoing in Production environment
 - System is in test-mode only- submission is not live – test proposals will be deleted April 27 after 8pm
 - Easy to navigate
 - Validations on the fly
 - See the [NSF website](#) for details on the launch
- Users need to Onboard... log into Research.gov and review your role(s)
 - Other Authorized User (OAU) role is for department admins
 - NSF migrated all with role PI...Department admins need OAU role
 - Request a role (e.g. view), and RA will update to remove PI and add OAU
 - You can onboard at any time; RA recommends onboarding now before “11th hour” proposal submission 😊
 - If you don't onboard, RA will slowly go through list and ‘invite you’ to onboard
