### Transfer Agreement with De Anza College: BS Psychology

De Anza students must successfully complete 90 quarter (60 semester\*) transferrable units with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA to be considered for admission to Northeastern University College of Professional Studies bachelor's degree programs. Only college level courses with grades of C or better will be considered for transfer.

Students interested in pursuing the **BS in Psychology** must successfully complete the **General Education/Breadth Requirements for A.A. / A.S. Degree** in addition to prescribed courses as noted below.
