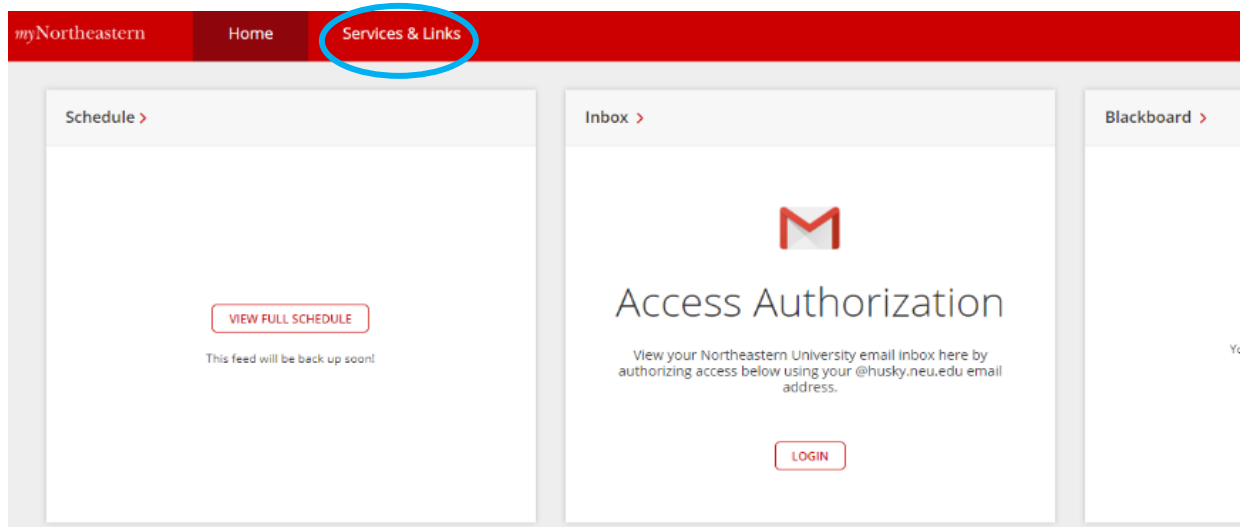

Introduction
Northeastern University's Housing and Residential Life system provides housing each term to eligible students. Accommodations include housing owned or leased by the University. All students must conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the University's expectations, as stated in the Guide to Residence Hall Living, the Student Handbook, the Residence Hall and Dining License Agreement, and any and all other applicable University policies, procedures, supplemental agreements, rules and regulations.

Acceptance of the License Agreement
In order to live in University housing, a student must read and agree to the terms of the 2020-2021 Residence Hall and Dining License Agreement (the "License Agreement") at the time the application is submitted. By signing the License Agreement online and/or by accepting keys or a keycard to enter a licensed room, suite, or apartment, the student shall be deemed to have acknowledged and accepted the terms and conditions of this agreement. Acceptance of the terms of the License Agreement, and applying to become a licensee, does not guarantee the student a space in University housing. Failure to accept the License Agreement may result in loss of housing privileges.

The University may, in its sole discretion, revoke this License Agreement and/or bring disciplinary action against a student for violations of any University policy or the terms of this License Agreement, the Guide to Residence Hall Living, or the Student Handbook. Students must comply with all requirements related to disciplinary proceedings, including but not limited to, suspension, or student conduct hearings. Notices to a student will be...

- Using the drop down menu, select your first, second and third choices of price point for housing. Please note, while the meal plan costs are listed here, you can only adjust your meal plan through Husky Card.
 - We encourage you to read the more detailed rates charts (both first year and upperclassmen) on our website.
- If you are interested in a single bedroom at a higher rate, please indicate yes in the box provided.
 - Indicating "yes" does not guarantee the availability of a single. Not indicating "yes" does not guarantee that you will not be placed in a single. Placement into single rooms is dependent on the number of singles that are available, and the number of students who preference them!
- Document any disability or medical need by selecting "yes" or "no" in the drop down bar.

What is a Living Learning Community?

[Living Learning Communities](#) are available in most of the traditional and some semi-private and apartment residence halls. Living Learning Communities (LLCs) bring students with similar interests, hobbies, and courses together to have access to community based activities and resources within the residence halls.

All NUin students will be assigned to a LLC even if you are not living in a residence hall that features one. You will be invited to participate in the LLC programming as a way to connect with other first year students in an area of your interest.
