POVERTY LAW CLINIC: This Clinic combines classroom instruction and representation of clients under the supervision of Professor James Rowan. The Clinic links legal doctrine and theory to the practice of law in a real world setting, focusing on issues of poverty and economic disempowerment. Students work on a range of individual cases as well as performing advocacy tasks for a variety of client community groups. Substantive law areas include many of the most difficult and controversial issues faced by poor people focused on the intersection and disjuncture of welfare and work. The course is thus both intensive and wide-ranging, providing students with practical experience in a number of “cutting edge” problems for both the legal profession and the larger society in the 21st century.
