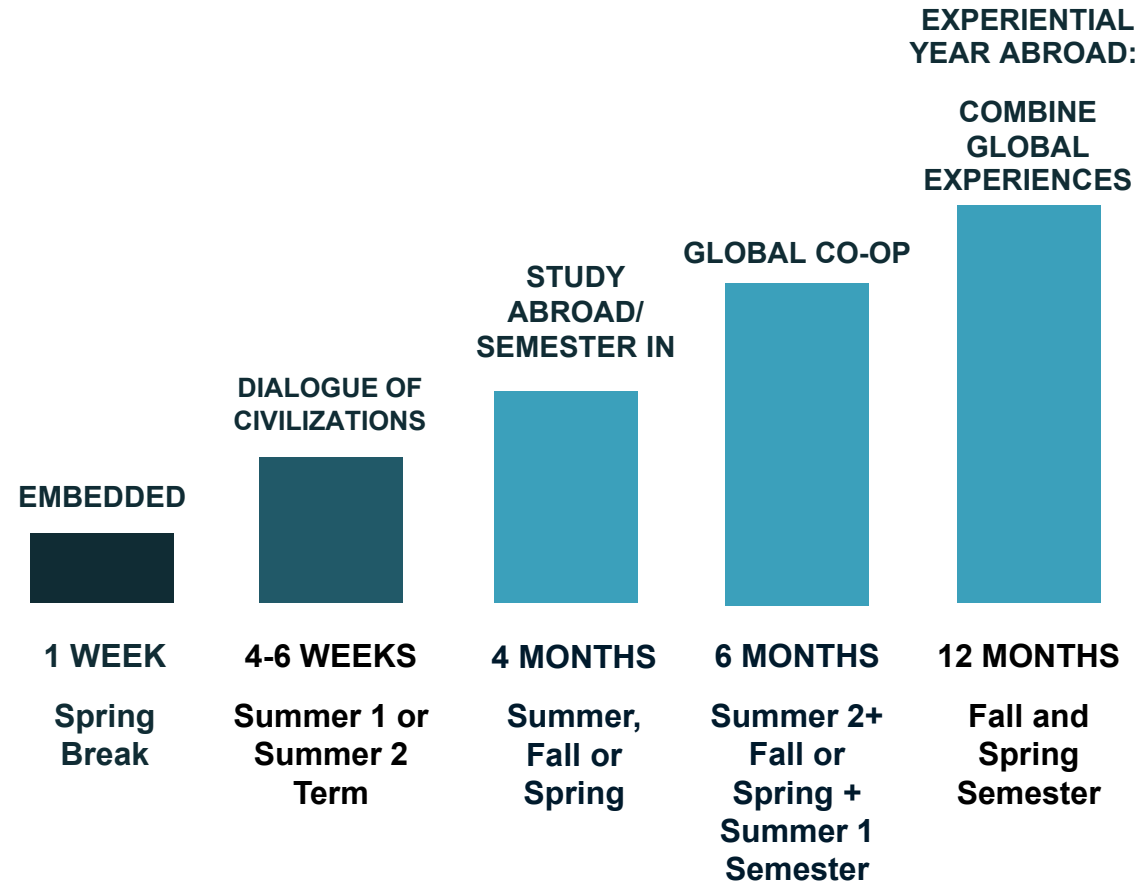

When Can Students Study Abroad?

Dialogue of Civilizations

- Students can participate in a Dialogue starting the summer after their first year at Northeastern.
- Dialogues run during summer 1 (May-June) or 2 (June-July)
- Group size ranges from 10-30 Northeastern students, with 1 or 2 faculty members

Study Abroad

- Students are eligible to study abroad after completing 2 semesters as a matriculated Northeastern student.
- Students can study abroad at a host university or program during summer, fall or spring semester.

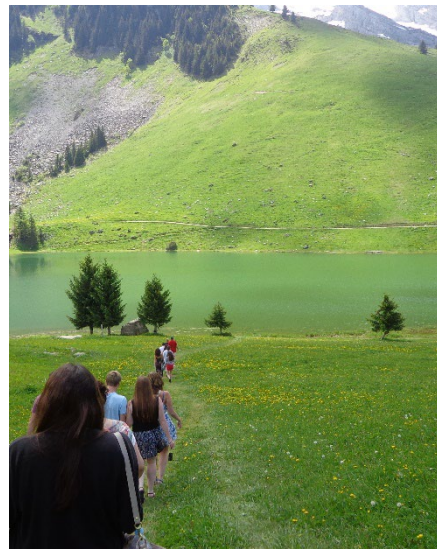

Faculty-led programs offered during the summer that focus on critical issues facing students and their peers at both the local and global levels.



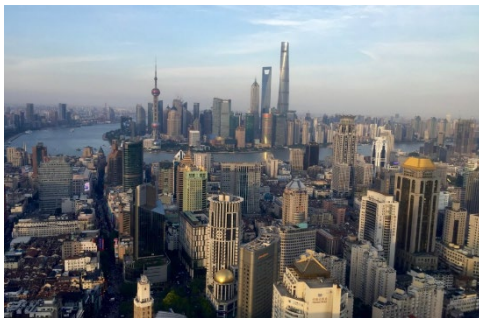

Dialogue of Civilizations Costs

- Northeastern Tuition for 8 credits + a Dialogue program fee
 - Program fees range from \$500- \$3,500
 - Northeastern Tuition and DOC Fee Includes: 8 Northeastern credits, accommodation for program duration, international security and emergency support, and program-related expenses (local transportation, field trips, excursions and group meals)
- Scholarships and Grants are available

Study Abroad

- Summer or semester-long course work at a foreign university that broadens students' academic experience and deepens their cultural experience.
- Students enroll directly into host university courses or an international program
- Classes are taught by local faculty and students are from different universities and countries
- Offered during Fall, Spring, Summer 1, Summer 2, and Full Summer semesters

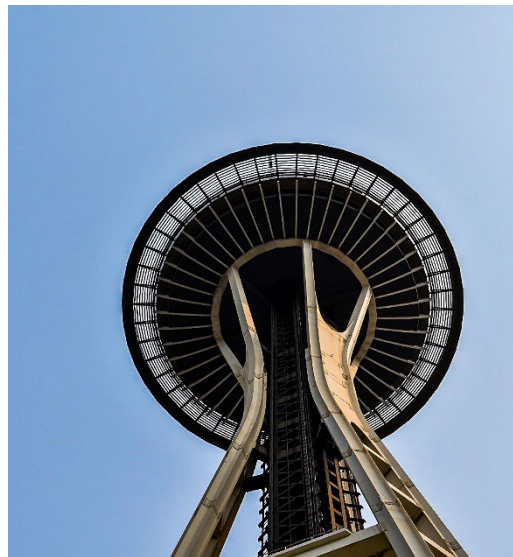


Semester In

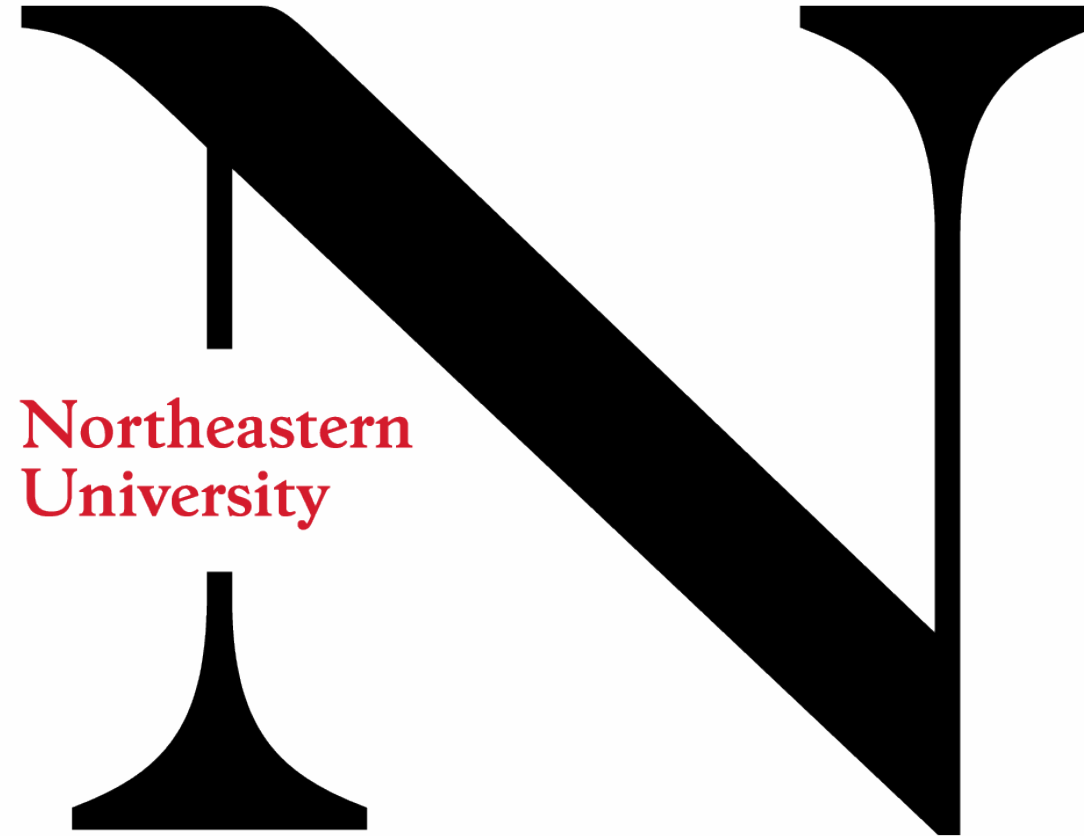
